



UNIVERSAL DESIGN FOR LEARNING
MULTI-SENSORY TOOLKIT

1. Sand or rice tray - to trace letters, words or numbers
2. Toobaloo - for students to speak into while reading (can be purchased at school supply stores/online)
3. Line readers - to follow along while reading text
4. Reading glasses in various strengths, magnifier
5. Stress ball/easy grip balls
6. Jumbo pencils
7. Various colored markers and highlighters-use different colors to emphasize words, instructions
8. Pipe cleaners-to form into letters, words, numbers
9. Sandpaper or textured surfaces-for tracing letters, words, numbers
10. Flashcards, sight word cards, playing cards, letter tiles
11. Hot Dots pens and card sets
12. Popsicle sticks/pipe cleaners - for counting, forming words, letters, numbers, to separate syllables
13. Textured letters and numbers
14. Magnetic or foam letters, shapes or numbers
15. Foam letters, shapes and numbers
16. Personal dry erase boards or chalk boards
17. Play-doh or clay to form letters, words, numbers
18. Old magazines to cut out letters, words, numbers or pictures of words
19. Graphic organizers
20. Audio spelling dictionary (available from the App Store or Google Play)
21. Bean bags toss game
22. Measuring tapes, cups, spoons, etc.
23. Coins, paperclips, or plastic chips and strips of paper to demonstrate math concepts
24. Fraction cubes
25. Learning Wrap Ups
26. Magnetic fraction tiles
27. Fraction circles
28. Tactile dice
29. Multiplication, division, addition, subtraction table charts
