

Adult Career Pathways Glossary

Find **ACP Glossary of Terms** in materials section of webinar or at ATLAS ABE (ACP Resources)

- On-ramp Designed for beginning and intermediate-level learners to introduce them to, and get them started on, a particular adult career pathway program.
- Bridge course Designed to prepare advanced-level learners for entry into and success in a post-secondary or other non-ABE training program.
- ▶ **IET** A service approach that provides adult education and literacy activities concurrently and contextually with workforce preparation activities and workforce training.

Data from 7/1/18 to 6/30/19

- → Served 213 students
- → 18,473 contact hours
- → ESL accounts for 75% of our students

10 total staff - all part time

- 1 coordinator
- 1 data manager
- 1 navigator
- 3 teachers
- 1 educational assistant in classroom
- 3 educational assistants in child care

- Improved family finances
- Learned new skills
- Enhanced self esteem
- Support system for one another
- Help their community

How did you and your program begin ACPs?

- CareerForce Awarded P2P grant in 2015 we were a partner (written in) - Paraprofessional Training
- CareerForce Awarded Southeast Asian Grant we were a partner (written in) - Drivers Training
- Asked by local community college to teach
 Developmental Math
- Asked students sewing and CPR/1st Aid certification
- MN ABE Content Standards
- Use Transition Funds Health Care Careers Exploration

Key advice for other programs

- JUST START
- Be intentional effective ACPs do not just happen
- Plan with partners
- Refer to WIOA's definition of Career Pathways
- Use existing resources
- Reach out to others in the field there is help out there
- OK to make mistakes it happens to all
- OK to start small

Metro South Career Pathways Overview Past 3 Years

2016 - 19 Navigator Services - ALL students

Total Student Services	428

Metro South Career Pathways 2016 - 19

Program Year	Participants	Contact Hours
2016-17	79	8037
2017-18	136	8554
2018-19	120	8006
Total	445	35, 811

2017-18: Added 2 *Phlebotomy*, a *CDL* and a *Construction* class. *ESL and CD* class moved from day class 16 hrs/week to evening 6 hrs/week to serve more students but with fewer hours

2018-19: Added small *NAR (CNA)* class. More students working = tight labor market

Learner Benefits Last Year

- Providing career navigation services = better workplace preparedness and outcomes
- Total measurable skills gains (Career Pathways ABE students) was 48.3%, above the 2018-19 NRS target of 43%.
- Due to <u>2017-18 ACP Program Development Cohort</u> goals of building enrollment and retention,
 - we maintained or surpassed our expectations for participant numbers in ALL career pathway classes except for NA Prep
 - > CP student retention rate was 77%
- Career fair experience (2nd year)

Data was gathered from other CP classes that were funded in other ways.



Lessons Learned and Key Advice

- Start small and okay to try out ideas- pilot a class
- Find support from others building Career Pathways programming, including your grant partners
- Funding
 - IELCE-IET (Civics) grant supports most of our CP programming (3 year grant cycle)
 - Regional Transitions funds- funding for pilot classes
 - Other? (P2P grants, school district hiring initiatives)
- Add career navigation, if possible:
 - AmeriCorps MN Opportunity Corps member
 - Navigation Program Start-up Handbook volunteer

Lessons Learned and Key Advice

Building a CP Program:

- Choose industry pathways, knowing your students and regional employment needs (ABE student interests, DEED LMI)
 - Show students their options and how to get stackable training that leads to <u>living wage</u> jobs (*Tipping Point* study, industry pathways charts)
- > Scheduling/enrollment processes (testing, text reminders)
- > Marketing (Facebook, website, information sessions, flyers, videos)
- Data tracking Who will do this? Important for obtaining grants (CP student data benchmarks, Career Navigator data, student surveys)
- Partnering with employers and CareerForce (Healthcare Advisory Council, employer panel events, career fairs, speakers, field trips)
- Partnering with post-secondary schools (Contracts to offer IET- ACP classes, potential Accuplacer testing at ABE, MOUs)

What is an Adult Career Pathway program?



"Career pathway" means a combination of rigorous and high-quality education, training and other services. An ACP:

- Aligns with regional/local industry needs
- Prepares participants for secondary and post-secondary educational success
- Includes counseling <u>supports</u>
- Offers education, workforce preparation and training concurrently (as appropriate)



What is an Adult Career Pathway program? (continued)

- Organizes education, training and support services to accelerate advancement
- Enables participants to earn <u>high school diploma</u> or equivalent + at least one <u>post-secondary credential</u>
- Helps participants enter or advance within a <u>specific</u> occupation or occupational cluster
