

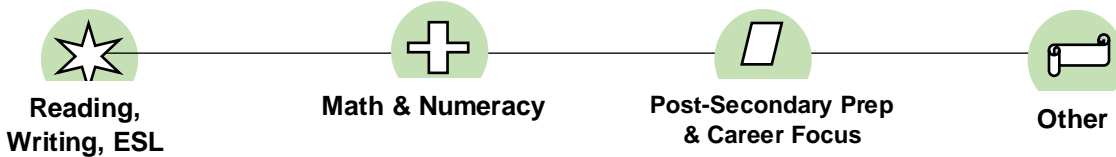
Suggested Professional Development (PD) Pathway for Staff in Multiple Roles
