	Ellii (Classes) - Yellow <i>Designed for assignments</i>	Ellii Solo - Blue <i>Designed for independent learning</i>
Time is eligible for distance learning proxy hours (if completed <u>outside</u> of class or other times when attendance is entered as contact hours)	Yes Time is tracked for digital tasks only , NOT for PDF activities.	Yes
Teacher can assign specific content to learners	Yes. Learn how in the Digital Homework section of Ellii's Help resources.	No. You can recommend specific items, but learners must navigate to them on their own. You can also provide links to specific items. Learners must already be signed in to Ellii for the links to work.
The platform recommends content to learners based on their placement test results or class level	No. If the teacher enables Student Picks , learners can “vote” for topics to study next.	Yes. Some teachers have reported inaccurate placement or other issues with the placement tests. Learners can retake the placement test. Learners who skip the placement test will automatically be placed on the Pre Beginner Learning Pathway.
Learners are limited to only level-appropriate or teacher-assigned content	Yes. Learners will only see what the teacher has assigned.	No. Learners are restricted to Learning Pathways at their level and below on the Home tab. However, learners can access additional content via the Library, Videos, and Shorts tabs.
Teacher can monitor learner progress (time and scores)	Yes	Sometimes, but very limited. You can ONLY view learners' progress if you are the teacher who created their accounts. Information is limited to time spent and activities started or completed (no specific scores or answers).
Teacher can provide feedback to learners	Yes. Learners receive automated feedback for many tasks. For speaking and writing, teachers can decide to provide feedback manually or enable the Ellii Bot AI feedback .	No. Learners only receive automated feedback.
